GENERAL RULES

1. Official Brahman Show Catalogue

A Catalogue with the latest official details will be supplied to the show, provided that:

- i. if the enclosed entry form is submitted at least one month before the show by fax or e-mail to the Brahman office;
- ii. the cut-off date used for the calculation of age for each Class will be the first day of the show month and must be submitted to the Brahman Office;
- iii. **Individual Class Entry** (will be specified by the Show Office).
- iv. **Show entry fees for animals on sale** (will be specified by the Show Office).
- v. **All animals on offer must be exhibited.**
- vi. no entry fees will be refunded after the closing date. Brahman Society, Brahman Bank Account, Standard Bank, Account number 0411 76871, branch code 055534;
- vii. entry fees are payable with registration to The Brahman Breeders Society.

2. Unofficial catalogue

If the show society prepares its own catalogue, the following **MUST** appear on the front page: **“Particulars not checked by Brahman Society”**.

3. Judges

Will be nominated by the Brahman Society. Details will be forwarded to the show committee. The Brahman Society contact person is Sietze Smit, nr. 083 712 9965, or the Brahman Office, 051-446 4619.

4. Identification and ownership

No animal without official identification in the ear and, if older than 15 months, without the official brand, will be allowed in the ring. If a purchased animal is not yet transferred to the exhibitor making the entry, the animal will be withdrawn.

5. Show society rules

Exhibitors must comply with all veterinary regulations, transport permits and other show affairs. CA and TB certificates must be presented at arrival of the animals.

6. Red and grey classes

If more than 30 red or grey Brahmans are entered, red and grey MAY be judged separate.

7. Pregnancy and fertility

Females which reached the age of 30 months (class 30 – 36 months) at judging day must be certified in calf or should have calved already. **Calf must be exhibited.** Heifers from 24 to 30 months need not be certified, but if certified in calf, it will be to their advantage.

Pregnancy tests must be carried out by a vet and such certification must be presented to the Brahman Technical Advisor (TA) before judging. The TA will forward these certificates to the office for filing.

8. Calving dates

Only calving dates (birth notification) which were submitted to the office in time, will be considered. Flushings will be considered if submitted via the official "Schedule O" form.

9. Calves

A cow without a calf or which is not in calf (pregnant), will not be judged.

10. Animal younger than 8 months

No animal younger than 8 months will be allowed or entered at the show

11. Maximum number of animals

No restriction will be placed on the number of animals entered by an exhibitor.

12. Super Cow, as well as Breedplan Male and Female will NOT participate in the Championships.

The Super Cow and Breedplan winners, male as well as female, may not participate in the Championships, unless they won their individual classes. Breedplan winners may also participate in the Breed Championship, not as Breedplan winners, but if they won a Championship (Calf-, Intermediary-, Junior- or Senior Class).

NON-HALTER TRAINED SHOW RULES

1. The presentation of Non-halter trained shows will be known as **Non-halter trained show** in order to distinguish it from halter trained shows. Example: Swarttruggens Non-halter trained 2019 or National Non-halter trained 2019..
2. The National Non-halter trained Show will be presented parallel with the National Championships.
3. The Society's show rules will be applicable except in cases where it is directly and logically in conflict with Halter trained show rules.
4. All handlers in the enclosures will be dressed in accordance with the rules.
5. The Judges' Policy of the Society will be applicable
6. Grey and Red animals to be judged separately. A minimum of 30 animals per type is needed to show separately. Less than 30 entries per type will be showed together.
7. Judges will be appointed by the Society.
8. If logistically expedient, entries may be limited.
9. **No animal may participate at the same show in both the halter trained and the Non-halter trained classes.**
 - (a) **No animal entered in a Halter trained class may be entered in the Non-halter classes in all future shows.**
 - (b) **An exhibitor may show different animals in the Halter trained and Non-halter trained classes at the same show.**
10. Group classes are not presented.
11. **Animals** older than 20 months showing a fresh branding (brand) shall not be judged
12. A Cow must be exhibited with her own **full registered Brahman calf.**
13. **A Calf exhibited with its Dam may not be older than 210 days on the day judging take place.**
14. **Only fully registered animals will be judge.**
15. **Male Animals**

A split between the testis (scrotum) of less than 5cm will be allowed.
16. **Scrotum circumference**

- A Brahdex score of less than 5 will not be placed.
17. Brahdex scoring will be done at shows where more than 80 animals are exhibited.
 18. Only three placings are made
 19. The show ring must be at least 18m x 18m.
 20. **Holding pens**
Enough holding pens must be available for the judging process.
Animals placed 1st and 2nd will be kept in the pens until judged for that category championship.
 21. Poor temperament – Animals that are difficult to control will be disqualified.
 22. Animals that are not show ready will be disqualified and **not be allowed** in the arena. The decision of the Technical official or other officially appointed person is final.
 23. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that animals entered be at the holding pen in time for the relevant class. The exhibitor's handlers must, after judging, return the animal to the pen or if necessary, to the waiting pen for the championships.
 24. No animal may be handled with a halter at any stage, irrespective of it being halter-trained or not. This is applicable for the full duration of the animal being at the show venue. .
 25. Organising committees to apply to the Society for a **Non-halter trained show** well in advance.
 26. The arena to be manned by two ring stewards as well one to let animals in and out of the arena. (Preferably Junior Judges will be utilised as ring stewards).
 27. Behind the enclosures at least 4 persons (1 in charge) are needed to extract and put back animals to be judged.
 28. A compulsory exhibitor's meeting must be called the day before judging to discuss rules with exhibitors.
